Red Mountain Trip: 2.6 miles (2 hours)

- Meet & Launch at Phon D. Sutton recreation site. (parking pass included)
- Paddle down the river for 2.6 miles to the exit called Granite Reef.
- Our shuttle will pick you and the equipment up from Granite Reef and bring you back to Phon D. Sutton

Avaiable End of Fall/Winter/Beginning of Spring

- We offer this kayaking trip when the beginning portion of the river (from the ranch down to Phon D. Sutton) is not operational for kayaking and other water sport activities. Each Fall, the Stewart Mountain Dam reduces the amount of water being released which causes the river level to decrease.
- The Verde River keeps the river flow from Phon D. Sutton to Granite Reef at levels that are suitable for water sports year round.
